TEACHING ECONOMETRICS USING SPSS IN POWER POINT PRESENTATIONS

Nowadays there exist a number of program packets which allows not only to computer specialist the application of multivariate analysis methods to use.

The increasing use of the programs is also caused by the increasing spreading and efficiency of the PC as well as of the more comfortable lay-out of user interface.

The program packet or program system we are referring to is SPSS (Statistical Product and service of Solutions).

We describe as program system a collection of programs with a common user interface. Hopefully SPSS will soon find a very widely spreading, particularly in the university area an in practice as well.

It is under many operating on mainframe computer, workstation and PC available.

2.3. The studying hour must have the character of a working hour.

The presentations of the method must be choused so, that the student shell be able execute all steps of the process.




Fig. 1 SPSS Data Editor presented in Power Point




Fig. 2 Histogram and normal distribution curve
